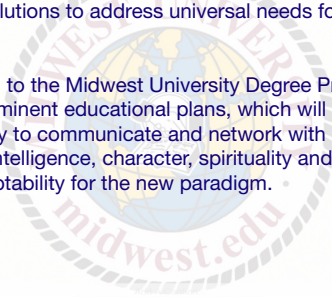

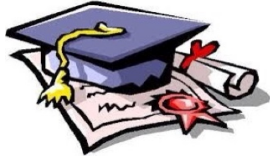

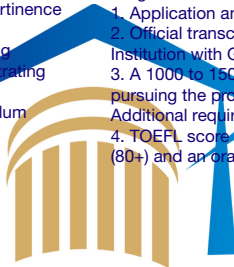

1. Exhibit the qualities of a professional performer through deeper training in their applied areas.
2. Establish research skills and performance ability in outstanding interpretation in music.
3. Prove outstanding communication skills in their research assignment.

Admission Requirements

1. Application form for admission \$100 (non-refundable)
2. A brief autobiographical statement
3. Official transcript appropriate for the program Master's degree in Music or its equivalent from an accredited institution.
- 3.0 out of 4.0 grade point average (GPA)
4. Audition:

Students who are applying for the Degree of Doctor of Musical Arts should make and submit an audition tape in their applied area with their admission application to the Admission Committee. For more information, they may refer to the Department of Music. An applicant for the DMA whose Master's degree was in a different applied area, will be required to take two master level courses and a master's recital for the same DMA applied area. The graduate recital requirement may be waived if the applicant had already completed three applied area courses or wants to take them all.

If the prospective students decide to follow the admission policy of taking the prerequisite three courses of the applied area as a pre-doctoral study, they will not be required to follow the audition procedure.

1. Applicant Qualifications:

- 1) Master's degree holder (Every major)
- 2) The completed course with grade C+ below would not be counted as credit hours. 3) GPA should be above 3.5.

2. Admission Procedures:

- Admission procedures consist of application screening, entrance exam, and interview.
- 1) Applicants should pass application screening before taking entrance tests.
 - Application includes applicant's essay, recommendation letters, and transcripts.
 - 2) The test areas are general knowledge (on world history, economy, and world trends) and English (reading).
 - English test would be waived for the applicants whose TOEFL score is 80 above or TOEIC score is 670.
 - 3) Program faculties interview applicants who take tests.
 - 4) Application screening, general knowledge test, English test and interview
 - 5) Faculty committee make all admission decisions.

3. Transfer Requirements:

- 1) The leadership-related courses with grade B above from Midwest Doctoral Program could be approved as transferring credits.
- 2) Transferring students must pass tests and interview.
 - The test areas are general knowledge (on world history, economy, and world trends) and English (reading).

> English test would be waived for the applicants whose TOEFL score is 80 above or TOEIC score is 670 above.

 - Program faculties interview applicants who take tests.

4. Graduation Requirements:

- 1) Ph.D. students must pass two exams, qualifying exam and oral exam in order to be Ph.D. candidates.
- 2) Ph.D. candidates must successfully complete their dissertation defense.
- 3) All dissertation drafts must be written in English.
