Pilot Requirements

- Must be at least 17 years old
- Must receive ground training as required in CFR Part 61.309
- Allowed to carry one passenger
- Operate only in Class G & E airspace
- No flights above 10,000 ft. MLS
- Must have a U.S. Drivers License and comply with its restrictions
- Pass an FAA Knowledge Test
- No business use of the aircraft, No flights after dark, 3 miles visibility
- No flight above clouds, as visual reference to the surface must be maintained. With endorsements you can:
- Operate an aircraft at speeds above 87 knots
- Operate in B, C & D airspace
