- 6. The case for leaving or dropping out of Midwest University after submitting the application form;
  - ① The Application Fee (\$100) is NON-REFUNDABLE.

2 Tuition fees will be refunded, according to the catalog refund policy listed below:

\* 15 week program - up to 1 week: 90%, 3 weeks: 70%, 5 weeks: 50%, 7 weeks: 30%; After 7 weeks will not be refunded in full \* 8 week program: 1 week: 90%, 2 weeks: 70%, 3 weeks: 50%, 4 weeks: 30%; There is no full refund after 4 weeks (Refund Processing Fee: \$ 30.00).

7. Those eligible for the scholarship must enroll in at least 12 undergraduate courses, 9 at master's level, and at least 9 at doctoral level in each semester. The curriculum must be completed within a period of time and all courses must be awarded at least B. In addition, in the case of leaving the university during the studies, the student is no longer eligible for scholarship at Midwest University.
